To guide your prayers during this fortnight...

- ♦ Lift up the people of Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe, still trying to rebuild their lives, a year after Cyclone Idai. Pray for the healing of the sick, comfort to the broken hearted, and provision for those now facing devastating droughts.
- ♦ Pray for all former footballers who suffer from dementia and for their families. Pray that more people of all ages be encouraged to take up physical activity.
- ♦ Pray for the people of Haiti where, water pollution, the lack of sewers and not having a safe way to dispose of rubbish is making the lives of people living in poverty even harder. Pray for protection from disease.
- ♦ Give thanks that the six women who testified against Mr Weinstein now feel a sense of closure. Pray that women in other industries will be encouraged to speak out against inappropriate behaviour in the workplace.
- ♦ Thank God that the last patient in the DRC being treated for Ebola has left hospital. Lift up everyone so far affected by Ebola; pray for peace and comfort for those who have lost loved ones to the disease.
- ♦ Following the budget, pray that the large increase in spending on roads will be used wisely. Give thanks for the increase in National Insurance thresholds, which will take 500,000 employees out of the tax altogether.
- ♦ Thank God for the young people in Nigeria using their time and creativity to protect their local environment and make their community safer. With their efforts recognised in the UK parliament this week, pray that this will inspire other young people to care for God's creation and help their communities too.
- ♦ Pray for the families of those who have died or are seriously ill as a result of the corona virus. Pray that its spread can be delayed, so that the total number of cases in the UK can be reduced.
- ♦ Pray that the investigations into Trevor Phillips' remarks and possible anti-Semitism in the Labour Party will both be investigated fairly and fully.

- ♦ Pray for insight & wisdom for Justin Welby, Archbishop of Canterbury.
